Apply until September 26, 2010.

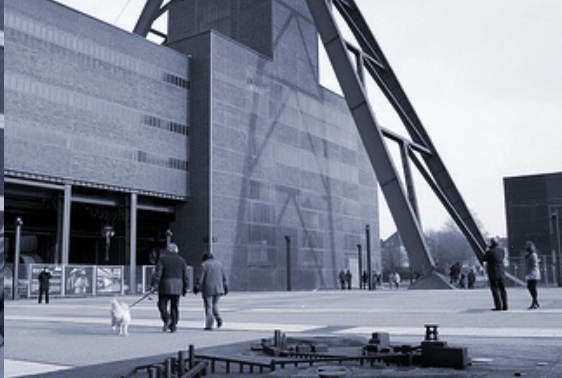


THEME
