The scholarship can take one or two years. The Robert Bosch Stiftung awards a monthly stipend and covers expenses for travelling and the advanced training program.

Limited additional funds are also available for language courses and teaching materials. The scholarship begins in August and ends in July of the following year.

Application

The annual application deadline for new scholarship holders is February 28, with the respective academic year starting in September. Universities that want to extend their existing lectureship also have to hand in their application by February 28. Universities that apply for the first time at the Lectureship Program have to send their application forms by December 31 of the preceding year.

Lectureship Program of the Robert Bosch Stiftung in Asia

The Robert Bosch Stiftung's Lectureship Program supports scholarship holders who teach German as a foreign language and carry out educational projects at universities in Asia. They play an active role in the educational work at their host university, are involved in activities to promote international understanding, and work on their own professional development.

The program year also includes an extensive array of advanced training measures within the fields of educational and project management as well as individual coaching.

The program is open to applications from university graduates from German-speaking countries as well as university employees from Asia who have a particular interest in teaching and project work. The lecturers are present in China, Indonesia, South Korea, Thailand and Vietnam.

Teaching and Project Work

The lecturers are part of the teaching staff at their respective universities and teach German as a foreign language. In addition to their work as language teachers, they advise students and university staff members about German-specific issues and organize extracurricular activities.

Apart from that, the lecturers carry out educational projects in the target countries of the program. Their focus lies on topics such as education management, socio-political and intercultural education, personality development and professional trainings for people involved in education.

Advanced Trainings and Project Coaching

The Lectureship Program supports the teaching and project work of the scholarship holders by providing a wide range of advanced training measures within the fields of educational and project management as well as key competences.

This advanced training program, which was especially developed for the Lectureship Program, combines practical trainings in project management, theoretical seminars and individual consulting in a one-of-a-kind way. The advanced trainings directly support the lecturers with accomplishing the tasks of their scholarship and furthermore constitute a basis from which to launch their career after completing the lectureship.

Additionally, each lecturer has the possibility to receive an individual coaching.
